Paving begins on Highway 529 between Champion and Little Bow Provincial Park

Champion... Motorists can expect speed reductions and delays on Highway 529 near Champion to accommodate paving.

Work begins May 24 to pave a 16-kilometre stretch from the junction with Highway 23 to the Little Bow Provincial Park access road. During paving, traffic may be reduced to alternating single-lane and be directed by flag people. The speed limit may be reduced to 50 km/h through the construction zone.

Paving will be completed by June 20, weather permitting.

Motorists should use caution in the area and obey all signs, message boards, and flag people. Motorists are reminded that fines for speeding are doubled through construction zones when workers are present.
