Sign work periodically stops traffic on QEII in Red Deer

Red Deer... Motorists can expect periodic nighttime stops on Queen Elizabeth II Highway in Red Deer to accommodate overhead sign work.

Traffic near the Highway 11A interchange may be stopped at various times between 11 p.m. June 7 and 5 a.m. June 8. The stoppages will be for a maximum of 10 minutes. The stoppages affect both northbound and southbound traffic, but will only be in one direction at any one time.

Motorists may wish to use alternate routes such as Highway 2A during the above hours.

Motorists should use caution in the area and obey all signs, message boards, and flag people. Motorists are reminded that fines for speeding are doubled through construction zones when workers are present.
