Highway 13 widening starts between Bawlf and Ohaton

Bawlf... Motorists can expect speed limit reductions, detours, and periodic lane closures on Highway 13 between Bawlf and Ohaton.

Work is underway to widen 20 kilometres of Highway 13 and widen and rehabilitate five culverts and/or bridges along the stretch. Gravel detours will be in place at the culvert and bridge sites and the speed limit will be reduced to 50 km/h in the construction zone. The \$16.6-million project will be completed by Oct. 15, weather permitting.

Motorists may wish to use Highways 26 or 854 as alternate routes to avoid the construction.

Motorists should use caution in the area and obey all signs, message boards, and flag people. Motorists are reminded that fines for speeding are doubled through construction zones when workers are present.
