Paving disrupts traffic near Carseland and Mossleigh

Mossleigh... Motorists can expect lane closures and minor delays on Highways 817, 23, and 24 in the Carseland and Mossleigh areas.

Paving is underway on Highway 817 north of its junction with Highway 901 near Carseland. The project also includes sideslope improvements.

Paving is also underway on Highway 24 south of the Bow River and on Highway 23 between Mossleigh and the junction with Highway 542.

For all these projects, traffic will be reduced to one-lane alternating with the speed limit reduced to 50 km/h through the construction zone. Paving will be completed by Sept. 15, weather permitting.

Motorists should use caution in the area and obey all signs, message boards, and flag people. Motorists are reminded that fines for speeding are doubled through construction zones when workers are present.

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
