Minor delays on Peace Region highways for surface treatment repairs

Grande Prairie... Motorists are advised that from June through to the end of September 2011 the following Peace Region highways will undergo crack repair and chip seal coating:

Highway 2;
Highway 33;
Highway 35;
Highway 40;
Highway 43; and
Highway 743.

Traffic impacts will include short duration lane closures with speed reductions, flag persons, and pilot vehicles.

The speed limit will be reduced to 50 km/hour when construction is adjacent to workers, and to 80 km/hour in recently chip sealed areas. All other locations will stay as posted.

Motorists are asked to use caution and obey all construction zone signing, flag persons, and posted speed reductions. Motorists are reminded that fines for speeding are doubled through construction zones when workers are present.
