Construction disrupts traffic on Highway 63 in Fort McMurray

Fort McMurray... Motorists can expect occasional short-term traffic disruptions on northbound and southbound lanes of Highway 63 north of the intersection of Highway 63 and Confederation Way in Fort McMurray for ongoing interchange construction.

Starting July 12, traffic will be detoured using temporary access lanes starting until further notice. Construction on the \$77.4-million second phase of the Confederation Way and Thickwood Boulevard interchanges will be completed by fall 2012.

Motorists should use caution in the area and obey all signs and flag people. Motorists are reminded that fines for speeding are doubled through construction zones when workers are present.
