## Paving delays traffic on Highway 604 near Morningside

Morningside... Motorists can expect minor traffic delays on Highway 604 from Range Road 272 to Highway 2A near Morningside.

Construction is expected to begin at the end of July. Sections of the road may be down to one lane and minor delays may occur. The speed limit through active construction zones will be reduced to 50 km/h and flag people will direct traffic. Construction is expected to be completed by August 31.

Later in September, Highway 604 will be shut down at the rail crossing west of Morningside. A local detour will be set up. Signage will be in place to direct traffic to local roads. This is expected to last two days.

Motorists should use caution in the area and obey all signs and flag people. Motorists are reminded that fines for speeding are doubled through construction zones when workers are present.
