Shaftesbury Ferry reopens near Grimshaw

Grimshaw... Motorists are advised that the Shaftesbury Ferry near Grimshaw is operating.

The ferry carries Highway 740 traffic across the Peace River south of Grimshaw. The ferry had been closed since June 28 for safety reasons due to high water levels and flows in the river.

The ferry operates from 7 a.m. to 11:30 p.m. daily.
