Fort Assiniboine... Motorists are advised that the Klondyke Ferry is now operating.

The ferry carries Highway 661 traffic across the Athabasca River east of Fort Assiniboine. The ferry had been closed since July 8 for safety reasons due to high levels and flows in the river. The ferry operates 6:30 a.m. to 11:30 p.m. daily.
