Highway 88 paving delays traffic near Red Earth Creek

Red Earth Creek... Motorists can expect minor delays on Highway 88 north of Red Earth Creek to accommodate paving the highway.

The work is underway to convert the highway from gravel to a paved surface from north of the junction with Highway 686 north of Red Earth Creek to Willow Creek. Traffic may be reduced to alternating single lane controlled by flag people. The speed limit will be reduced to 50 km/h through the construction zone.

The project will be completed by Oct. 15, weather permitting.

Motorists should use caution in the area and obey all signs, message boards, and flag people. Motorists are reminded that fines for speeding are doubled through construction zones when workers are present.
