Paving on Highway 16 reduces speed limits near Vermilion

Vermilion... Motorists can expect lane closures and speed limit reductions on Highway 16 near Vermilion to accommodate paving.

Paving begins Aug. 6 on the westbound lanes from Minburn to east of Vermilion, including the Vermilion vehicle inspection station adjacent to the westbound lanes. Traffic may be reduced to one lane and the speed limit will be reduced to 80 km/h through the construction zone. The work does not affect the eastbound lanes.

Paving will be completed by Oct. 15, weather permitting.

Motorists should use caution in this area and obey all signs, message boards, and flag people. Fines for speeding are doubled in construction zones when workers are present.

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
