Ramp construction closes pedestrian access across Anthony Henday Drive in Edmonton

Edmonton... Residents are advised that the pedestrian pathway across Anthony Henday Drive on the Callingwood Road interchange in Edmonton will be closed for approximately six weeks.

The closure begins Aug. 25 and accommodates construction of the interchange's new southbound ramp. Lessard Road is the nearest alternate pedestrian access across Anthony Henday Drive.

Alberta Transportation is working closely with the City of Edmonton to coordinate adjacent city road construction work in order to minimize disruptions for motorists and pedestrians.
