Sign installation requires nighttime closures on Anthony Henday Drive in Edmonton

Edmonton... Motorists can expect nighttime closures on Anthony Henday Drive in Edmonton to accommodate overhead sign installation.

Northbound Anthony Henday Drive will close to traffic between 87th Avenue and 111th Avenue at 10 p.m. on Aug. 30 and reopen at 6 a.m. on Aug. 31, weather permitting.

Southbound Anthony Henday Drive will close to traffic between 87th Avenue and 109th Avenue at 10 p.m. on Aug. 31 and reopen at 6 a.m. on Sept. 1, weather permitting.

The closures are taking place at night to minimize disruptions to traffic. Motorists are advised to use alternate routes during the closures.

Alberta Transportation is working closely with the City of Edmonton to minimize traffic disruptions to motorists for interchange construction on Anthony Henday Drive at Stony Plain Road, Lessard Road, Callingwood Road and Cameron Heights Drive.

Motorists should also use caution in these areas and obey all signs and message boards. Motorists are reminded that fines for speeding are doubled through construction zones when workers are present.
