Weekend paving closes lanes and ramps on Anthony Henday Drive in Edmonton

Edmonton... Motorists can expect lane and ramp closures on Anthony Henday Drive this weekend between 87th Avenue and Whitemud Drive.

Starting at 5 a.m. on Sept. 10, southbound Anthony Henday Drive will be reduced to one lane between 87th Avenue and Whitemud Drive. The closure accommodates paving the southbound lanes. Southbound traffic will be restored to two lanes by 6 p.m. on Sept. 11.

The ramp from southbound Anthony Henday Drive to westbound Whitemud Drive will close to traffic at 5 a.m. on Sept. 10 and reopen at 6 p.m. on Sept. 11. The closure accommodates paving the ramp.

Alberta Transportation is working closely with the City of Edmonton to minimize traffic disruptions to motorists for interchange construction on Anthony Henday Drive at Stony Plain Road, Lessard Road, Callingwood Road and Cameron Heights Drive.

Motorists should also use caution in these areas and obey all signs and message boards. Motorists are reminded that fines for speeding are doubled through construction zones when workers are present.
