Minor traffic delays to be expected on Steinhauer Bridge

Fort McMurray... Motorists are advised that there will be minor traffic delays on the Steinhauer Bridge, between Morrison and the Athabasca River.

Beginning on Friday, Sept. 23, work will be done both northbound and southbound on Highway 63 on the existing median of the Steinhauer Bridge between Morrison and the Athabasca River. Although there will be a reduction in roadway width along both alignments, at least two lanes will remain open in both directions. Median work is expected to be completed by Sept. 30, weather permitting.

Motorists should use caution in these areas and obey all signs and message boards. Motorists are reminded that fines for speeding are doubled through construction zones when workers are present.
