Traffic delays on Deerfoot Trail northbound to be expected this weekend

Calgary... Motorists are advised that there will be lane restrictions and speed reductions on Deerfoot Trail at Calf Robe Bridge and Ogden Road Bridge.

From Friday, Sept. 23, at 9:30 p.m., to Sunday, Sept. 25 at 8 a.m., there will be additional lane restrictions and speed reductions to 50 km/h on Deerfoot Trail from Calf Robe Bridge to Ogden Road Bridge to accommodate bridge construction. Traffic will be reduced to one lane each night between 9:30 p.m. to 8 a.m.

From Sunday, Sept. 25, at 7 p.m. to Monday, Sept. 26, at 5 a.m., one lane will be open to traffic on the Calf Robe Bridge to accommodate a phase change that will switch traffic from the two right lanes to the two left lanes.

Motorists should use caution in the area and obey all signs, message boards, and flag people. Motorists are reminded that fines for speeding are doubled through construction zones when workers are present.
