Bridge work closes lanes on Highway 892 near Ardmore

Ardmore... Motorists can expect lane closures and minor delays on Highway 892 near Ardmore.

Repair work begins Oct. 5 on the bridge carrying Highway 892 over the Beaver River. The work involves repairs to the deck overlay and joint leakage.

During the project, traffic will be reduced to alternating one-lane controlled by signals and/or flag people. A minimum lane width of 5.5 metres will be maintained at all times. The repairs are expected to be completed by Oct. 30, weather permitting.

Motorists should use caution in the area and obey all signs, message boards, and flag people. Motorists are reminded that fines for speeding are doubled through construction zones when workers are present.
