Add a Teams background

Before a meeting

- 1. Go to your Teams calendar.
- 2. Select a meeting and select **Join**.
- 3. From the pre-join screen, select **Background Filters**
- 4. Select **Add new** and then select the new image from your computer. Make sure it's a .JPG, .PNG, or .BMP file.
- 5. The text on the image will appear in reverse in your preview but it will appear correctly to others.

To turn off background effects, select **None**. Your background will persist in all your meetings and calls until you change it again.

Note: If you don't see this option in the menu, the feature might not be available on your device.

During a meeting

- 1. Join a Teams meeting.
- 2. In your meeting controls, select Camera > Video effects and settings 🔝.
- 3. Select Video settings.
 - a. Select **Add new** T to upload and use an image from your computer. Make sure it's a .JPG, .PNG, or .BMP file.
- 4. Select Preview to view the background before you apply it.
- 5. Select Apply.
- 6. The text on the image will appear in reverse in your preview but it will appear correctly to others.

Customize your Outlook signature

- 1. Navigate to the **Email Signature** panel in Outlook by following the instructions below:
 - a. Select File (top left corner)
 - b. Select Options (near the bottom left)
 - c. Select **Mail** (near the top left)
 - d. Select Signatures (on the right)
- 2. Click in the text area of the Edit signature field.
- 3. Copy and paste a signature from below into the field.
- 4. Edit the information as necessary.
- 5. Click **OK** to close the window.

Add a frame or overlay to a photo

- 1. Download the frame or overlay and save it somewhere that is accessible to you. Save the photo you want to place the frame/overlay over.
- 2. Use a photo editing tool to place the frame/overlay on top of your photo.

Note: Canva is a free tool that can be used to do this:

- a. Visit <u>canva.me/photo</u>-frame-effect.
- b. Log in or create a free account.
- c. Click Uploads from the left side of the screen.
- d. Click Upload.
 - i. Upload your photo.
 - ii. Upload the overlay/frame.
- e. Drag your photo from the uploads panel onto the canvas.
- f. Drag the frame/overlay from the uploads panel onto the canvas. iii. Do not place it directly on top of your photo, or it will replace the photo.
- g. Once your photo and frame are both on the canvas, reposition and resize your photo and the frame/overlay as required.
 - iv. Fill the whole white canvas, or you'll have white space around the edges when you download.
- h. Click Share in the top right corner.
- i. Click **Download** at the bottom right of the dropdown.
- j. Click **Download** again at the bottom of the dropdown.
- 3. Use your new photo on social media.
