
2020 Labour Mobility Dashboard

Labour mobility highlights



In 2020, **30%** of the 46,183 new domestic applications for all regulated occupations in Alberta were from out-of-province certified individuals.



Between 2019 and 2020, the total number of out-of-province applications increased by 20%.



Processing times



In 2020, the average processing time for new Alberta applicants and out-of-province certified workers was **6 business days**.

40% faster than the 2019 average of 10 business days.
