


## Alabama – Alberta Trade \$USD

Alberta and Alabama's relations are anchored in manufacturing, agriculture and energy. Alabamabased companies, including Vulcan Materials and Drummond Company, collaborate with Alberta firms on natural resource development and infrastructure projects.

Alberta exports industrial machinery, chemicals, and metals to Alabama, supporting its automotive and manufacturing industries. We share a growing interest in renewable energy technologies, with Alberta offering expertise in carbon capture and storage. Trade delegations and forums foster ongoing collaboration in sectors like logistics and advanced manufacturing.

The University of Alberta and the University of Calgary participate in the National Student Exchange (NSE) program, which includes member institutions in Alabama such as the University of Alabama and Alabama State University. The program facilitates student mobility and academic collaboration between Alberta and Alabama, enhancing cultural and educational ties.
