

Alberta Snapshot

Capital Power, an Alberta independent power producer, owns and operates the La Paloma Generating Facility in Kern County, California. This 1,062 MW combined-cycle natural gas power plant was acquired by Capital Power in February 2024.

The facility plays a crucial role in supporting the reliability of California's electricity grid. It has resource adequacy contracts in place through 2029 with multiple investment-grade utilities and load-serving entities, ensuring a stable supply of electricity to meet the state's energy demands.
