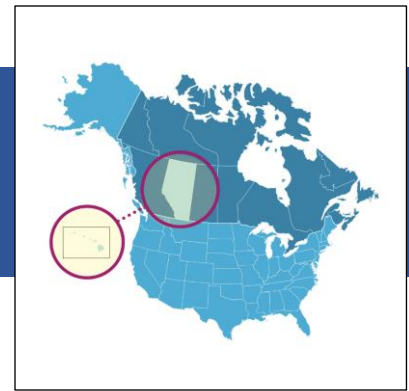


## Hawaii and Alberta: Strong Partners, Trusted Neighbors

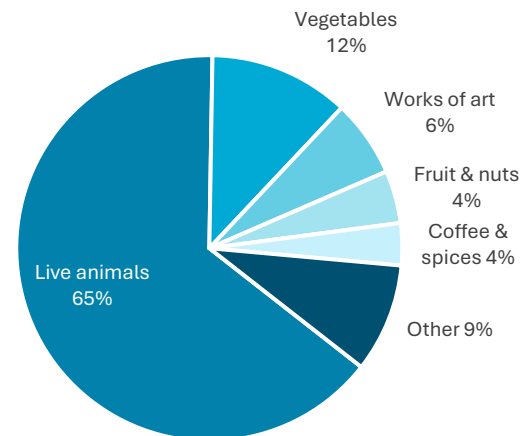
- **1,792** Hawaii jobs are supported by trade with Alberta

## Alberta Snapshot

As one of Canada's largest airlines, WestJet connects Hawaii with the continental North America through year-round direct flights to four different Hawaiian destinations – Oahu, Maui, Kauai and the Island of Hawaii. Headquartered in Calgary, Alberta, the airline helps ensure that more than 150,000 Albertans are able to visit Hawaii each year while connecting the Aloha State with more than 150 other destinations in Canada, the United States, Central America, the Caribbean, and Europe. WestJet carries out 1,610 annual round trip flights to Hawaii, providing seats for a staggering 286,000 passengers.

WestJet not only provides reliable transportation to and from Hawaii, but also invests in the many communities it serves via a variety of charity endeavors and a dedication to sustainable practices. Because of WestJet's investment in fuel-efficient aircraft and focus on improving operational performance, it has increased its fuel efficiency by 47.1% per revenue tonne kilometer between 2000 and 2017.
