

Alberta Snapshot

Stantec, a global design and engineering firm headquartered in Edmonton, Alberta, has a significant presence in Illinois. With four locations in Chicago, as well as offices in Monee and Naperville, Stantec is contributing to the state's economy through job creation and sustainable infrastructure development.

With Stantec on board for the design, Chicago's historic 111 Monroe will be converted into a mixed-use building set to include 345 apartments, 226 hotel keys, and event space on the second floor. The roof level will be reactivated by reopening the original Monroe Club as an amenity for residents and hotel guests.

Stantec's office in the Willis Tower connects them to the past while looking toward the future. A project with their first client - the Chicago Board of Trade - resulted in the first high-rise in Chicago to incorporate high-voltage risers, reducing construction costs while providing electricity crucial to the business.
