

### Alberta Snapshot

The Louisiana-Alberta relationship is heavily influenced by energy and petrochemicals. Alberta companies like Methanex and Inter Pipeline work closely with Louisiana's petrochemical industry, while Louisiana-based firms such as ExxonMobil have significant operations in Alberta.

Alberta exports crude oil, refined petroleum, and chemicals to Louisiana, supporting its refineries and export hubs, while The Port of New Orleans is a key point for Alberta products reaching global markets.

Cultural ties are enriched by tourism exchanges thanks to Mardi Gras celebrations in New Orleans and Alberta's annual Calgary Stampede, reflecting a mutual appreciation for history and cultural diversity.
