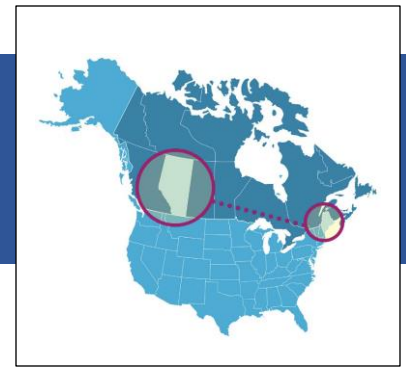


## Maine and Alberta: Strong Partners, Trusted Neighbors

- Alberta is Maine's 14<sup>th</sup> largest trading partner

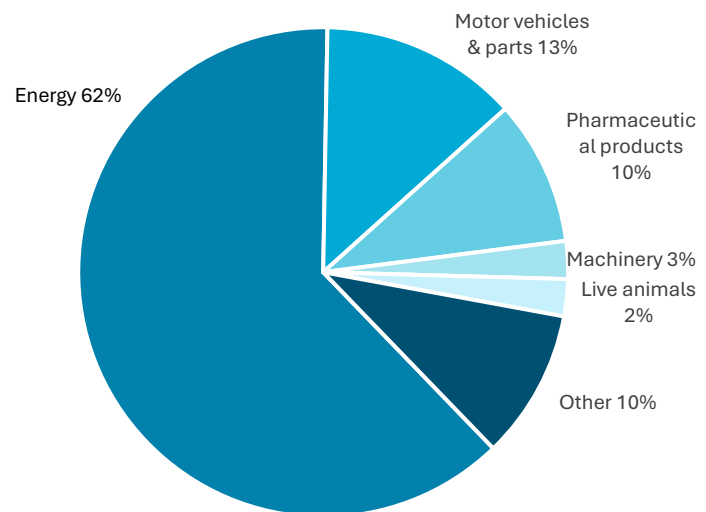
### Maine – Alberta Trade \$USD

## Alberta Snapshot

Stantec, a global design and engineering firm headquartered in Edmonton, Alberta, has over 250 offices throughout the United States, including two in Maine. With locations in Portland and Topsham, Stantec is contributing to the state's economy through job creation and sustainable infrastructure development.

For years, the economic growth of Portland Harbor's historic working waterfront was increasingly threatened by the lack of adequate berthing room caused by decades of sediment accumulation. To help remedy this, Stantec set out to create the first contained aquatic disposal cell in Maine. This solution will stimulate waterfront economic development by dredging and disposing sediments from berthing areas, some of which have not been dredged in over 70 years. Once the removed materials are cleaned for offshore disposal, Portland Harbor will have cleared berthing areas and a more secure economic future.
