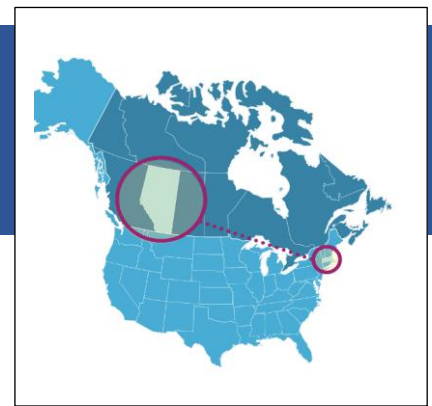


## Massachusetts and Alberta: Strong Partners, Trusted Neighbors

- Alberta is Massachusetts' 23<sup>rd</sup> largest trading partner



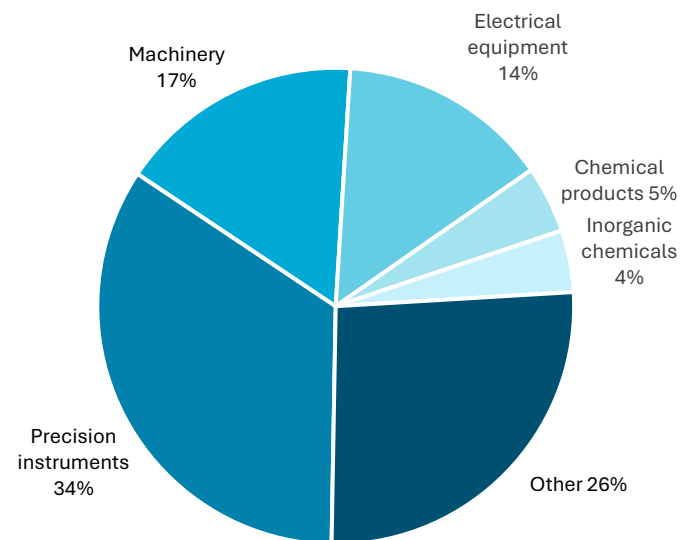
### Massachusetts – Alberta Trade \$USD

- Bilateral trade: **\$629.5 million**
- Massachusetts exports to Alberta: **\$57.2 million**
- Massachusetts imports from Alberta: **\$572.3 million**

- Precision instruments: **\$19.5 million**
- Machinery: **\$9.5 million**
- Electrical equipment: **\$8.2 million**
- Chemical products: **\$2.6 million**
- Inorganic chemicals: **\$2.4 million**

### Alberta Snapshot
