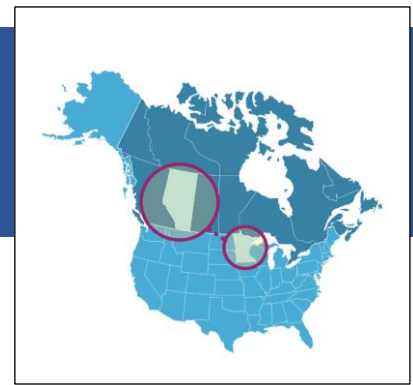


Minnesota and Alberta: Strong Partners, Trusted Neighbors

- Alberta is Minnesota's largest trading partner

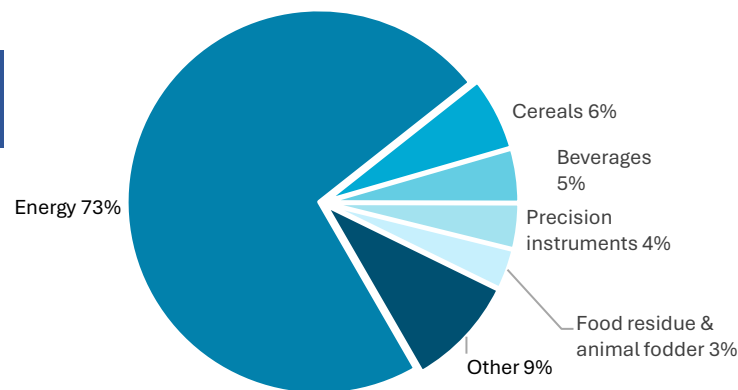
Minnesota – Alberta Trade \$USD

- Cereals: **\$80.1 million**

Alberta Snapshot

Stantec, a global design and engineering firm headquartered in Edmonton, Alberta, has a significant presence in Minnesota. With six offices in Duluth, Minneapolis, Plymouth, Rochester, St. Cloud, and Woodbury, Stantec is contributing to the state's economy through job creation and sustainable infrastructure development.

The City of Cold Spring grappled for decades with rising nitrate levels in its tap water. With the help of Stantec, they turned to biological treatment to reduce this chemical salt. The \$6.5 million Cold Spring nitrate reduction plant - Minnesota's first - opened in 2023 and reduces nitrate levels to near zero. The plant was also designed with future expansion in mind and is adaptable to changing regulatory considerations.
