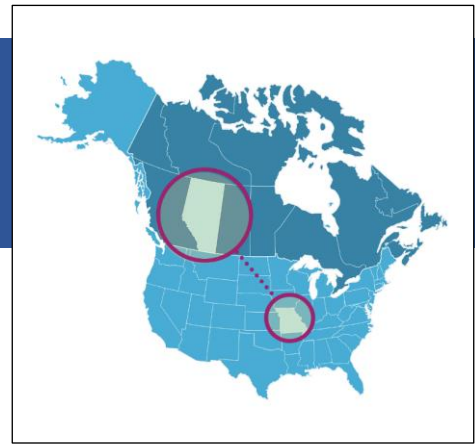


## Missouri and Alberta: Strong Partners, Trusted Neighbors

- Alberta is Missouri's 12<sup>th</sup> largest trading partner

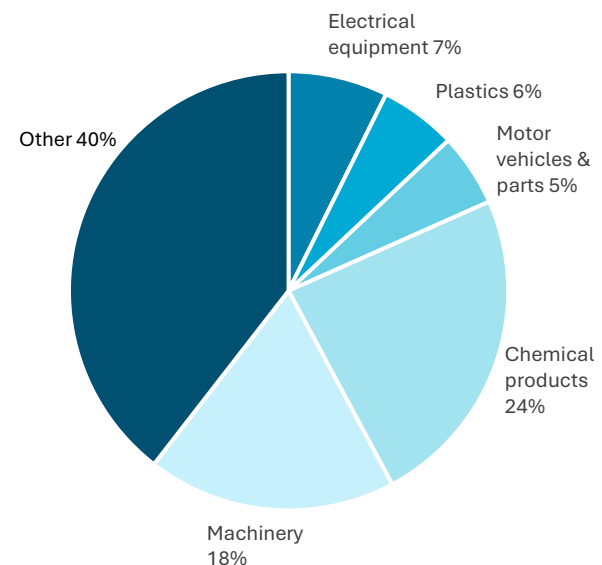
### Missouri – Alberta Trade \$USD

- Bilateral trade: **\$696.4 million**
- Missouri exports to Alberta: **\$70.9 million**
- Missouri imports from Alberta: **\$625.5 million**

### Missouri's Top Exports to Alberta \$USD

- Chemical products: **\$16.9 million**
- Machinery: **\$13 million**
- Electrical equipment: **\$5.2 million**
- Plastics: **\$4 million**
- Motor vehicles & parts: **\$3.8 million**

## Alberta Snapshot

North America's first and only transnational single-line rail network connecting the United States, Canada and Mexico came together in 2023 through the historic merger of Missouri-based Kansas City Southern and Alberta-based Canadian Pacific.

With its U.S. headquarters in Missouri, CPKC owns the naming rights for the first privately financed purpose-built 11,000-seat stadium for professional women's soccer located in Kansas City.

From its Kansas City intermodal terminal, CPKC connects rail as far north as Vancouver, Canada and as far south as Central America.
