
- Bilateral trade: \$84.5 million

#### Alberta Snapshot

Calgary-based energy companies including Enbridge and TC Energy play a key role in supporting New Mexico's energy infrastructure, including natural gas transportation. In addition, Edmonton-based Stantec engineering provides engineering services from residential to retail and from water to oil and gas through multiple locations across New Mexico.

Trade includes Alberta exports of machinery and equipment, vital for New Mexico's mining and construction industries. Collaboration on renewable energy is also growing, with Alberta's expertise in wind and solar aligning with New Mexico's renewable energy goals.

Tourism between the regions is another area of development, with Albertans drawn to New Mexico's unique landscapes and cultural experiences.
