

Alberta Snapshot

Ohio's largest refiner, Calgary, Alberta-based Cenovus, employs almost 1,200 people and has plans to invest \$1.5 billion to the end of the decade.

Its Toledo refinery has a processing capacity of up to 160,000 barrels per day, producing gasoline, diesel fuel, and jet fuel, while its Lima refinery can handle 183,000 barrels per day and ships its products to Ohio, Illinois, Indiana, Pennsylvania, and Michigan.
