



Alberta Snapshot

Stantec, a global design and engineering firm headquartered in Edmonton, Alberta, maintains 250 U.S. offices, including two in Portland. The company has served the Pacific Northwest in one way or another for more than a century.

In 2024 Stantec led permitting efforts for a 622-mile fiber optic network spanning Oregon, California, and Nevada. This project seeks to provide affordable broadband services to underserved rural areas, enhancing connectivity and supporting economic development in these communities.

Serving as the program manager, Stantec is overseeing the planning, design, and construction of a new water supply system to meet the future demands of Washington County. This \$1.3 billion program includes the development of over 30 miles of pipeline and is anticipated to support regional growth and economic development.
