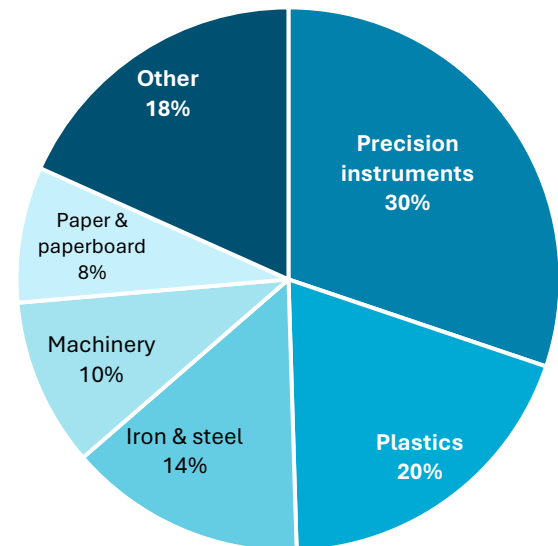
- **1,716** Rhode Island jobs are supported by trade with Alberta

Alberta Snapshot

Alberta is the number one supplier of oil and gas to the United States and plays an integral role in North American energy security.

Calgary, Alberta-based Enbridge, a multi-national pipeline and energy company, moves about 20% of the natural gas consumed in the U.S. and is the largest natural gas supplier to New England, the Southeast and virtually all of Florida.

Enbridge's Algonquin Gas Transmission pipeline transports 3.09 Bcf/d of natural gas through 1,131 miles of pipeline through New Jersey, New York, Connecticut, Rhode Island, and Massachusetts, connecting to the Texas Eastern Transmission and the Maritimes & Northeast pipelines. Its peak day design capacity enables Enbridge to offer abundant and reliable natural gas at a competitive rate.
