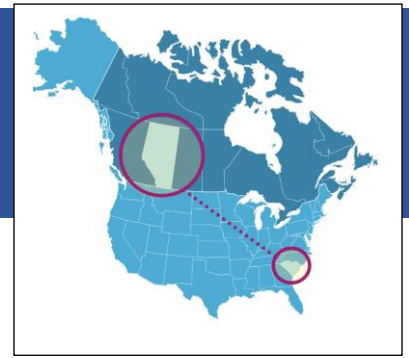


## South Carolina and Alberta: Strong Partners, Trusted Neighbors

- **904,000** U.S. jobs are supported by trade with Alberta

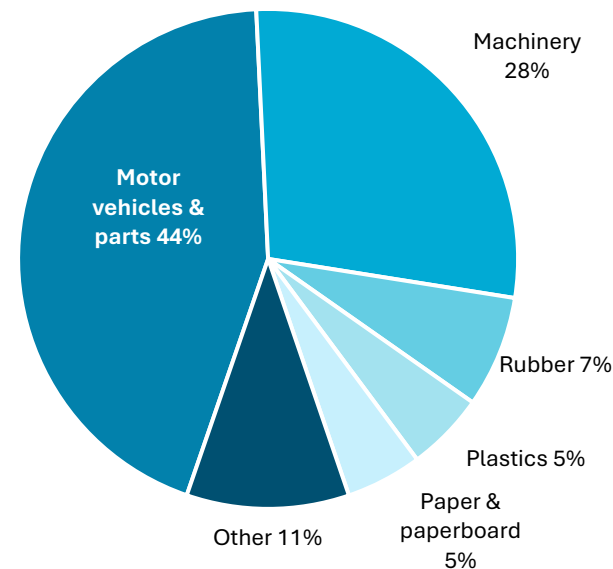
### South Carolina– Alberta Trade \$USD

- Machinery: **\$34.4 million**

### Alberta Snapshot
