

Alberta Snapshot

MEG Energy is a Calgary-based oil sands producer working in long-term partnership with Laramie-based Western Research Institute to improve and increase Wyoming's capabilities and development of heavy oil upgrading technology. Wyoming, Alberta, and neighboring states and provinces share a vast and valuable resource base of heavy oil reserves.

Working together, the partnership has yielded numerous successes, not least of which is HI- Q° – a proprietary process designed to partially upgrade heavy oil while removing diluent which is costly and takes up valuable pipeline space. Hi- Q° delivers a product that can be processed in more refineries at substantially lower cost, with fewer emissions than full upgrading while increasing transportation efficiency over the North American pipeline network.
