Some **professional occupations** and **designated occupations and trades** are regulated occupations in Alberta. Professional occupations are regulated by professional regulatory bodies and designated trades and occupations are regulated by Alberta Apprenticeship and Industry Training (AIT). advantage

Only those who have an Alberta job offer in a regulated occupation **and** who meet the requirements set out by the professional regulatory body or AIT to practice in that occupation in Alberta will be awarded points.

The AAIP also collects the following information in the Worker EOI to support selection for draws to meet sector labour needs and other program priorities. The AAIP does not award points for these factors:

- Status with Immigration, Refugees and Citizenship Canada (work permit status and federal Express Entry profile information)
- **National Occupational Classification (NOC) code (2021 version)** of your Alberta Job offer occupation
- Primary line of business of your Alberta job offer employer identified using a **4 digit North American Industry Classification System (NAICS) code (2022 version)**
