Community

The Municipal District of Greenview is the third-largest rural municipality in Alberta, with a population of 8,584 located approximately 350 kilometers northwest of Edmonton. The municipal district includes a number of hamlets including Grovedale, Ridgevalley, DeBolt. Little Smokv. and the mountain community of Grande Cache. The community's economy is based on oil and gas, forestry and tourism. Our borders encompass the Sturgeon Lake Cree Nation and the towns of Fox Creek, and Valleyview, while Grande Prairie is our neighbour to the west. The main administration office is located in the Town of Valleyview with satellite offices in DeBolt, Grovedale and

Grande Cache. The MD of Greenview has an annual operating budget of \$178.5 million, and is governed by a council of 11 councillors. The Municipal District of Greenview is a nature lover's paradise. Greenview's provincial parks and recreation areas offer unique experiences such as Musereau's spring-fed lake to sailing or fishing on Sturgeon Lake, and the breathtaking 30 metre Kakwa Falls. The municipality has three state-of-the-art recreation facilities located within the Town of Valleyview, Grande Cache and the Town of Fox Creek. Just south and east of the City of Grande Prairie, you will find a network of trails and wilderness perfect for hiking, all terrain vehicles, snowmobiling, fishing, hunting, camping, down-hill skiing at Nitehawk Year-Round Adventure Park, hiking through the Split Rock at Sulphur Gates or mountain biking along Griffith's Trail. The Grande Cache Tourism & Interpretive Centre showcases the fascinating history of the area through exhibits and displays featuring ice age artifacts, dinosaur tracks, Aboriginal heritage and fur trading, full animal mounts, tree and geological descriptions and local industry.
